   <sup>7</sup> For I endure scorn for your sake, and shame covers my face.
   <sup>8</sup> I am a foreigner to my own family, a stranger to my own mother's children;
   <sup>9</sup> for zeal for your house consumes me, and the insults of those who insult you fall on me.
- When I weep and fast, I must endure scorn;
   when I put on sackcloth, people make sport of me.
   Those who sit at the gate mock me, and I am the song of the drunkards.

# Psalm 69:13-18

<sup>13</sup> But I pray to you, Lord, in the time of your favor; in your great love, O God, answer me with your sure salvation.
 <sup>14</sup> Rescue me from the mire, do not let me sink; deliver me from those who hate me, from the deep waters.
 <sup>15</sup> Do not let the floodwaters engulf me or the depths swallow me up

or the pit close its mouth over me.

- <sup>16</sup> Answer me, Lord, out of the goodness of your love; in your great mercy turn to me.
- <sup>17</sup> Do not hide your face from your servant; answer me quickly, for I am in trouble.
  - <sup>18</sup> Come near and rescue me; deliver me because of my foes.



## Psalm 69:19-28

<sup>19</sup> You know how I am scorned, disgraced and shamed; all my enemies are before you.

Scorn has broken my heart and has left me helpless;
 I looked for sympathy, but there was none, for comforters, but I found none.

They put gall in my food and gave me vinegar for my thirst.
 May the table set before them become a snare; may it become retribution and a trap.

<sup>23</sup> May their eyes be darkened so they cannot see, and their backs be bent forever.

#### Psalm 69:19-28

- <sup>24</sup> Pour out your wrath on them; let your fierce anger overtake them.
- <sup>25</sup> May their place be deserted; let there be no one to dwell in their tents.
- For they persecute those you wound and talk about the pain of those you hurt.
- <sup>27</sup> Charge them with crime upon crime; do not let them share in your salvation.
- <sup>28</sup> May they be blotted out of the book of life and not be listed with the righteous.
