
TERMS & CONDITIONS

ELIGIBILITY

1. Entries for the in/Equality photography competition will be considered from still photo-based media including analogue and digital photography.
2. Multi-panel works may be accepted. A multi-panel work is considered as one work and to be eligible for selection must be shown in its entirety in one digital image.
3. Entrants must be at least 18 years of age at time of submission.

ENTRY

4. The selection of finalists will be judged in digital form only. Entrants are permitted to submit multiple photos however only one entry per person will be considered in the finals.
5. Entries must be emailed to in.equality.photography@gmail.com; arriving by 5.00pm, 16th of May, 2010.
6. Entrants must submit:
 - a. A completed entry form.
 - b. JPEG file approximately 2MB, at 300dpi and able to be opened on PC format.
 - c. JPEGs must be saved with the following file name format:
Surname_initial_image number.jpg
e.g. smith_j_1.jpg.
 - d. JPEG file name must correspond with entry details listed on the entry form.
 - e. Each entry must be submitted with a 100 word summary of the photograph.
7. The top 5 entries will be printed by the organisers for use of exhibition at no cost to the entrants.
8. Consent must be gained from subject for the purpose of display and non-commercial use.

EXHIBITION AND JUDGING

9. All entries accepted for the exhibition will be printed for display on the 29th of May, 2010 at Meeting Room, Clayton Community Centre.

10. Finalists will be contacted by email and are required to prepare a 3 minute speech regarding their inspiration of their piece.
11. All finalists are required to be present on the exhibition night.
12. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
13. Final judging will take place once the works have been installed. The winners will be decided by the general public and announced on the night.
14. The entrant must consent to the Organisers reproducing the entered work in all publicity and promotion including all electronic/digital or print media, subject to the organisers' discretion.
15. The organisers reserve the right not to exhibit any work if the work is not, in their opinion of sufficient artistic merit, technical and formal resolution, or of an explicit nature.

PRIZES

16. First, second and third prizes will be awarded. The first place winner will have a choice of which prize he/she would want to have followed by the second place winner. The third place winner will receive the remaining prize. The prizes are as follows:
 - a. Lomo Fisheye No. 2 Camera
 - b. Lomo Diana+ Camera
 - c. Lomo Action Sampler Camera
17. Prizes are subject to change at the discretion of the organisers.
