James 5:19-20

5:19 My brothers and sisters, if one of you should wander from the truth then someone should bring that person back,

5:20 remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of their ways will save them from death and cover a multitude of sins.

1. Perspectives towards those who have stumbled in their faith

- Secular perspective :
 - Admire the strong; Despise the weak
- So we may not bring the lost back to God
- Reasons:

- 1) Lack of caring love
- 2) Covering up sins with wrong intention

2. James' plea: Love those who stumbled in faith and bring them back to God

Why should we bring the lost back to God?

Luke 15:7 "I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent

God's will - Sinners repent; the lost turn around
