# 6 WAYS to get involved



## PRAY

- Sign up to our Global Workers' newsletters or pray through our church's Prayer & Praise Points for Global Workers each month
- Watch and pray through "Prayercast" videos
- Join or start a mission prayer group
- Download the PrayerMate app and subscribe to mission prayer feeds
- Use a prayer guide and pray for the unreached every day for one month

## GO

- Go on a Short Term Mission trip
- Use your Teaching, IT, Photography, Finance, or Hospitality skills to serve the mission field
- Help with the children's program/kids ministry at mission conferences and trainings overseas
- Business or profession as mission
- Visit our Global Workers or Partners

## SEND

- Financially support a Global Worker or Partner
- Connect with Global Workers regularly
- Adopt a Global Worker as a Life Group
- Host or provide practical help for Global Workers while they are on Home Assignment
- Help reach out to or care for Global Workers' families/elderly parents here in Australia

## LEARN

- Attend mission conferences such as Activate
- Enrol in a mission course such as Kairos or Perspectives
- Read books about missions, cross-cultural ministry, unreached people groups and missionary biographies
- Get involved in a mission discussion group
- Follow mission orgs on social media to see mission stories, fun facts, articles and prayer needs

## MOBILISE

- Invite people to mission events or activities
- Advocate for a global worker, unreached group or missions in general
- Read and share mission books or resources
- Coach or mentor someone in their mission journey
- Organise for someone to share about missions to your group

## WELCOME

- Show hospitality to those from overseas
- Consider being a 'home stay' family for international students
- Connect with those in your neighbourhood, workplace or community from unreached areas
- Volunteer in migrant support ministries such as Encounter English Learning
- Intentionally visit, shop or live in multicultural areas to connect with people

## Global Vision

Our vision is “to see indigenous disciple-making movements among unreached people groups.” God’s heart is not just addition but multiplication.

## Introduction

- Where in life do you long to see multiplication?
- Why do you think God designed us that way?

## Read & Reflect Together

### Read John 12:24

- Jesus says fruitfulness comes through a seed “falling and dying.” How does this connect with Jossy’s point that multiplication begins with subtraction?
- Where in your life might God be asking you to “die to self” so new life can grow?

### Read Matthew 28:18–20

- Jesus commands us to “make disciples of all nations.” How is this different from just adding converts?
- Jossy reminded us the vision is multiplication, not addition. What would multiplication look like in our homes, workplaces, or church?

### Read Mark 10:17-27

- The rich young ruler couldn’t surrender. What fears or comforts might hold us back today?

### Read John 6:1-14

- The boy gave his loaves and saw a miracle. Where could God multiply something small in your life if you surrender it?



## Sermon Summary

From Genesis to Revelation, God's heart has always been to multiply His Kingdom. Yet today, over 3.5 billion people still have little or no access to the gospel. Revelation 5 gives us a vision of heaven where people from every tribe, tongue, and nation worship the Lamb who was slain. Jesus is worthy — and He calls us to join His mission.

Sometimes we feel weak, unqualified, or even resistant, but God often works powerfully through our weaknesses. Like George Stott, the one-legged missionary to China, or countless biblical figures, God uses broken vessels to scatter seeds that multiply His Kingdom. Every believer has a role — we are no longer spectators, but actors in God's story.

## Read & Reflect Together

- Read Revelation 5:1-10 What does this passage reveal about God's ultimate vision? How does this stretch your view of mission?
- How do you respond to the reality that 3.5 billion people still lack access to the gospel?
- In Luke 5:1-11 Jesus calls His disciples to be "fishers of people." Which of the 6 Ways (Go, Send, Welcome, Mobilise, Learn, Pray) could you take a step in this week?
- George Stott, a one-legged missionary, said: "I do not see those with two legs going, so I must." What excuses or weaknesses hold you back?
- Read 2 Corinthians 12:9 How have you seen God's strength show up in your weakness?



## Sermon Summary

From the beginning of Creation, God calls us to be fruitful and multiply. Multiplication is embedded in God's design, it is the natural direction of the Gospel, and multiplication glorified God because missions glorifies God.

## Read & Reflect Together

- Read Genesis 1 & Matthew 28:18-20 What parallels do you see between these two passages? What differences do you notice?
- Read Revelation 7:9-10 If we have been called to missions, what implications does this passage have on those who have yet to hear the gospel?
- Read 2 Corinthians 5:14, 17-20 What do you think the ministry of reconciliation means? What would it look like in your life and for us as a church?
- In Mark 1:16-18, Jesus told his disciples to cast a net into the sea. When God calls us to be fishers of men, we may think of holding a fishing rod, catching fish one by one, but missions is more likened to many of us holding a net together. How does this change the way you think about God's mission and your involvement?
- Chris McMillan said "The gospel was never meant to be stationary. It was never meant to be confined to buildings, programs, or traditions. It was meant to go. And it will go. The only question that remains is whether we will go with it." What are the biggest fears or barriers that stop you from going with it (the gospel)?
